The proposal will be adjudicated on the basis of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act No.5, 2000), and the regulations pertaining thereto (2001), as well as the O. R. Tambo District municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy. The 90/10 preference points system will be used as per the ORTDM policy where 30 points will be for functionality, 60 for price and 10 for HDI status
